A review of the Clackamas Community College Web Page

Generally, I would say the web site follows its own guidelines very well. If there are any blatant oversights, I could not find them. Point by point, here is my assessment.

1. No over use of medium on the site. Clear links to content that is denser.
2. Design is easy to follow and seems like it is narrow enough to fit on any screen.
3. Until I needed to look at video or other rich content, I needed no special plug-ins.
4. The site is written in a journalistic style.
5. All pages load very quickly. Graphics that are there are small.
6. The pages are consistent with the same look and feel and navigation.
7. A simple style is used and the site does not look cluttered. In fact, it may be a bit sparse for my tastes.
8. Thank you for not putting hard to read text on backgrounds that are difficult to see. Site is black on white.
9. I have not tried to print, but by the design of the pages, the site is printer friendly and I will not need to spend a fortune in ink to print pages.
10. All of the elements on the pages are consistent and easy to follow.
11. The text justification recommendations are followed and easy to read.
12. Body text and page length is short. I do not see how this is possible on a regular basis with content rich sites unless you have 100's of pages on the site.
13. The site is open with lots of white space as we say in advertising.
14. Pages read left to right and top to bottom.
15. No big tables at all.
16. Navigation is on every page. Easy to follow and navigate.
17. Identification and footers are on every page as well as revised date etc.
18. Pages self center.
